Nick, a life long resident of Schaumburg Township, has served as the Coordinator of the Schaumburg Area Democratic Organization's Young Democrats Program. He is a Chemistry Teacher, Chair of the Science Department and Varsity Baseball

Nick has also worked part time at the Library for over 10 years and he feels this gives him a unique outlook to add to the board. "The library has given me, and our community, so much over the years I felt it was time that I gave back in a small way. My expertise on the inner-workings of the library will give the board an outlook from the "trenches."

Early Voting Period for February 2, 2010 Primary Election: January 11-28, 2010

Voters in Illinois have had the convenience of voting beginning the 22nd day preceding an election.

Just remember to bring a government-issued photo ID such as a passport, driver's license, or military ID. All Early Voting is conducted on touch screens.

Voters do not need to provide an excuse or reason why they cannot make it to the polls on Election Day. You need only to fill out an application at the Early Voting site.
